### Six Inch Hoop Challenge - 2018 Theme 'PARTY'

Use any form of hand embroidery and/or textiles within a 'six inch' wooden embroidery hoop to complete your interpretation of "PARTY". *Machine embroidery will not be accepted.*

The hoops will be hung against a wall, so there is no need to finish the back of the piece. Run a gathering thread around the excess fabric, draw it to the back and fix in place. Align the tightening screw with the top of the work as this will be used for hanging.

**Prizes - 1st \$70, 2nd \$50 & 3rd \$30**

Winners selected by Viewer's Choice. Please do not sign your work, but include your name on the back of the hoop. Feel free to enter as many pieces as you like. *There is no entry fee.*

# Conditions of ENTRY in Creative Needlework Section

- 1. Entry Forms and Fees must** be received by **Friday 29 June 2018 - 5pm**
- 2. Delivery Tuesday 10 July 2018, 9.30am - 2.00pm.** Works must be personally delivered to **Maclean High School, 7 Woombah St, Maclean** or delivered by courier to **Ferry Park Gallery.**
- All work must be labelled with Title, Selling Price, Section, Artist Name & Phone Number
- If work is **Not For Sale**, indicate **NFS** under **Sale Price in your entry form**
- 5. Exhibitors under 18 years of age must have a Parent/Guardian sign the entry form**
- LCACA reserves the right to hang and display at the exhibition, and to reject any work submitted.
- LCACA accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to any item entered
- Artists will allow their work to be photographed without a fee during the exhibition for print media and other publicity
- Depending upon the number of entries, all prizes may not necessarily be awarded
- The decision of the judge is final. LCACA will not enter into discussion or correspondence regarding a decision
- A **25% commission applies** to all sales and should be considered in pricing
- Works are to be **collected between 2.30pm to 3.30pm Sunday 15 July 2018**, no earlier or later unless prior arrangements have been made with the Stewards
- Unsold work not collected after 30 days will incur a penalty of \$20 or disposal of work. Works not collected will be disposed of at the discretion of LCACA
- 14. All works** (unless able to stand alone) **must include a method of hanging for display purposes**
- The dimensions of the work must be stated on the entry form
- A short description of the work, particularly any unusual forms of needlework that are not familiar to non-embroiderers would be appreciated. Please include this information on a piece of card no larger than 10cm x 10cm
- It is the responsibility of the maker to have obtained permission from the tutor or designer for the use of any design, including from a workshop
- Works that are more than two years old or have won a major prize elsewhere will not be eligible for judging. **We would appreciate these items for viewing by the public**
- Works that are not to be judged, but are for sale, may be entered for the sum of \$5, which will be deducted from the commission if sold.
- Works for **display only - NO FEE.**
- 21. All items must be clearly marked if For Sale or Display only**
